A42 Grasslands Wildflower Improvements Scheme

I am writing to inform you that we will be carrying out essential improvement work on the A42 between Junction 12 and 14. The work will be carried out in three phases, the first to start 29th May 2018 and will last for approximately one week. The second and third phase will look to take place September and November 2018. These works are in line with the National Pollinator Strategy and Highways England's 'Our Plan to protect and increase biodiversity'.

The works aims to improve the species richness of 2.27ha of soft estate grassland at eight sites on the A42 between junctions 12 and 14.

Safety is our top priority and to maintain a safe working environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to put traffic management in place for the duration of the work. To minimise disruption to customers, we will carry out the work using night-time lane closures.

We recognise that in delivering our plans there is never a good time to carry out essential maintenance works on our busy road without inconveniencing some road users. Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum
