## Small Grant Scheme

The small grant scheme can help communities get schemes and projects started. Groups can apply for up to £500 for a new and innovative project for the local community. The funding can be put towards one-off expenditures, new equipment, providing better services, and reaching more people. ## Coalville Special Expenses Community Chest Grant Scheme

This is a grants programme to support and encourage a range of community activities, initiatives and events that meet the needs of residents within the following wards; Coalville, Bardon, Snibston, Thringstone and Greenhill. Groups can apply for up to £250 and consideration will be given to all applicants that can demonstrate the benefits of their project or organisation for the local community within the areas stated. ## Green Grants

As part of the Green Footprints initiative, we are offering Green Grants of £500 each for environmentally-focussed community projects across the district.
