

Weekly Construction Update – Friday 9th June 2017

Ashby-de-la-Zouch, Junction 13 – A42/A511/A512 Roundabout Improvements

THIS WEEK

The installation of drainage gullies, drainage and concrete kerbs and the laying of type 1 stone, has been ongoing on the A511 eastern verge. Excavation works commenced on the 4th June on the A42 north exit slip, in preparation for the widening works. Excavation works for the new carriageway widening on the A512 southbound towards Shepshed have been completed and the installation of drainage is ongoing in preparation for the installation of new kerbs. The installation of ducting and Type 1 stone on the A511 Westbound, adjacent to the roundabout, has been ongoing in preparation for carriageway widening. On the northbound A42 slip road, trial holes have been dug and cable diversion works have taken place.

NEXT WEEK

On the A511 Eastbound the installation of new drainage system will be completed and the laying of drainage kerbs will commence. On the A512 eastbound kerbing and ducting installation will continue. On the A42 northbound off slip excavation and major earthworks will commence.

ONGOING NIGHT TIME ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

The A511 will continue to be closed southbound between the roundabout and the turning at Corkscrew Lane. Please be aware that there is still a diversion in place. Nighttime works will continue next week between Sunday and Thursday during the hours of 8:00 pm and 6:00 am. The download festival is taking place this weekend and the A511 will remain open until midnight on Sunday 11th June. The closure of the northbound exit slip of the A42 at Junction 13 closure is for approximately 8 weeks. Diversion routes are signposted with traffic directed to continue along the A42, to junction 14 and undertake a U-turn to travel southbound on the A42 and exit at J13 using the southbound exit slip.

May we ask that you follow the correct diversion routes as sign posted and please adhere to the speed limits in place at all times. The diversion are in place to minimise disruption for residents in surrounding villages and the speed limit has been implemented to ensure the safety of our workforce and all drivers. Bus services along the route are unaffected. **Information for the diversion route can be found on the website below** or please feel free to call Joanne Plews.
