

## Weekly Construction Update – Friday 16th June 2017

### Ashby-de-la-Zouch, Junction 13 – A42/A511/A512 Roundabout Improvements

#### THIS WEEK

On the A512 southbound the installation of new kerbs has taken place and the trimming of stone in preparation for the base and binder course. The laying of these courses will be carried out on the 26 to 28<sup>th</sup> June. On the A511 eastbound the installation of the drainage and gullies has been completed. On the A511 eastbound and westbound new kerbs have been installed, along with Type 1 stone, in preparation for the installation of the base and binder layers also taking place on the 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> June. Ducting and drainage has been installed on the westbound corner of the A511. On the A42 northbound off slip we have cut the earthwork layers and installed some of the fill material in this area. Various testing has taken place all week and all traffic management (TM) lane restrictions have remained the same and will continue next week.

#### NEXT WEEK

On the A512 eastbound, kerbing and ducting installation works will continue and is planned for completion along with the concrete infill in the narrow sections. On the westbound corner of the A511 the road box dig will be completed and Type 1 stone will be installed. Material fill will continue on the A42 north exit slip road in the excavated areas.

#### ONGOING NIGHT TIME ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

The A511 will continue to be closed southbound between the roundabout and the turning at Corkscrew Lane. Please be aware that there is still a diversion in place. Nighttime works will continue next week between Sunday and Thursday during the hours of 8:00 pm and 6:00 am. The closure of the northbound exit slip of the A42 at Junction 13 closure is for approximately 8 weeks. Diversion routes are signposted with traffic directed to continue along the A42, to junction 14 and undertake a U-turn to travel southbound on the A42 and exit at J13 using the southbound exit slip.

May we ask that you follow the correct diversion routes as sign posted and please adhere to the speed limits in place at all times. The diversion are in place to minimise disruption for residents in surrounding villages and the speed limit has been implemented to ensure the safety of our workforce and all drivers. Bus services along the route are unaffected. **Information for the diversion route can be found on the website below** or please feel free to call Joanne Plews.
