

Weekly Construction Update – Friday 28th July 2017

Ashby-de-la-Zouch, Junction 13 – A42/A511/A512 Improvements

THIS WEEK

Ducting for the street lighting and traffic signals is ongoing about the roundabout, this has been followed by the installation of new street lighting columns and lanterns. The trimming of the verges around the A511 and A512 has been completed. The carriageway resurfacing of the roundabout has been completed and traffic signal detection loops, road studs, road markings and anti-skid surfacing have been installed on/in the new surfacing.

NEXT WEEK

The install of new signals and street lighting will continue, with the erection of new lighting columns and signal poles. New road markings and traffic signal loop cutting will continue. The installation of vehicle restraint barrier will commence on the south-eastern verge of the A512, on the approach to the roundabout. The installation of ducting for traffic signals and street lighting will continue. The installation of new pedestrian guardrail on the A511 splitter island, on the Ashby side will commence.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

The existing traffic signals on the roundabout will be switched off on Sunday evening (30/07/17) to facilitate the install of the new signals around the roundabout. The signals will remain non-operational until the new traffic signals are commissioned in mid-August. Lane closures will be implemented overnight on all approaches to the roundabout, Sunday to Friday next week.
