

Weekly Construction Update – Friday 11th August 2017

Ashby-de-la-Zouch, Junction 13 – A42/A511/A512 Roundabout Improvements

THIS WEEK

The installation and connection of the new street lighting columns and lanterns has commenced. The restraint barriers on the south eastern verge of the A512 are now in place. New pedestrian guardrail has been installed on the A511 splitter island Ashby side and the studs for the two crossing points are now in place. Hard standing is being laid to improve visibility on the south eastern splitter of the A512 at the junction of the roundabout.

NEXT WEEK

Works will continue on the connection of new lighting columns around the roundabout. The removal of the old street lighting columns will take place. Installation of traffic restraint barriers will commence on the A511 east side and back filling and trimming works will be ongoing around the area. Some lane closures will be implemented to accommodate the works. The commissioning of the new traffic signals and pedestrian facilities is planned for the evening of the **13th August 2017**.
