

Weekly Construction Update – 1st December 2017

Discovery Way, A511 Bypass and Tesco Roundabout Improvements

THIS WEEK

Excavation has commenced for the new right hand turn in and out of Discovery Way on the A511 Ashby Bypass. Excavation work to prepare the ground to match the level of the new road formation in the splitter island has commenced this week. The installation of ducting for the infrastructure of the new lighting columns and signs is well under way. The surfacing of the carriageway around the roundabout and the installing of the new road line markings were completed on Monday morning ahead of the programme. The A511 road widening has been completed and the main traffic management system has been removed. There are still some small areas where barriers are necessary. The exit at the junction of Discovery Way and the A511 Ashby Bypass will be fully open today.

NEXT WEEK

On Discovery Way, we will continue to install ducting in the centre of the splitter island and in the widening on the east side of the carriageway. Type 1 stone will be laid. Excavation works will commence in the footway and kerbside to form the new maintenance layby.

A42/A511/A512 Flagstaff Roundabout Update

Works are continuing in regards to the installation of traffic signs for the Highways England network on the A42 slip roads. Ad hoc A42 slip lane closures will remain in place until works are complete.
