### Discovery Way, A511 Bypass and Tesco Roundabout Improvements

#### THIS WEEK

The adverse weather has played a part in the progression of works this week, however we have managed to continue installing the infrastructure for the new traffic signals and lighting in the splitter island at the junction with the A511 Ashby Bypass. The installation of new kerbs on the splitter island has also commenced. On the south west widening on Discovery Way we have installed boxes to accommodate the traffic signal loops.

#### NEXT WEEK

Works to install the infrastructure for the new traffic signals and lighting will be ongoing in the new splitter island on Discovery Way. Kerbing works will continue followed by the installation of Type 1 stone. The team will be preparing the site for the Christmas shut down period.

#### Eurovia's Christmas Shoebox Appeal 2017

As a division, we operated a 'Shoe Box Appeal' during the month of November. Thinking of others at this festive but lonely time of the year, we decided to support a charity for the homeless in Manchester called 'Mustard Tree'. The charity was grateful for the donation.
