

Weekly Construction Update – 19th January 2018

Discovery Way, A511 Bypass and Tesco Roundabout Improvements

THIS WEEK

The installation of the new traffic signals has been ongoing this week. The edgings and binder course have been installed on the splitter islands and in the footways. We have completed the installation of the tactile paving on the new pedestrian crossings. Traffic signal installation is ongoing. We have completed the construction of the maintenance layby with the installation of new drainage kerbs and Type 1 stone and concrete has been laid in the widened area in the carriageway.

NEXT WEEK

The 6mm surface course will be installed on the footway on Discovery Way. The new traffic signal installation will be ongoing. On Wednesday through to Friday the surfacing of Discovery Way and the A511 Ashby Bypass will commence during night time hours. The inbound access from the A511 Ashby Bypass to Discovery Way is programmed to be closed and will reopen at 6:00 am on Saturday 27th January 2018. These works are of course subject to weather conditions.

IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURES

Discovery Way surfacing and road lining works will take place during the night-time hours of 8:00 pm to 6:00 am from Wednesday 24th January 2018 until Friday 2nd February 2018. During the night-time works Discovery Way will remain closed. The current inbound closure on Discovery Way is programmed to be lifted **during daytime hours only** from Saturday 27th January 2018, leaving both the access and egress open. Traffic management will be implemented on the A511 Ashby Bypass where one lane and two-way traffic signals will be in operation.

A42 Junction 13

We have taken the opportunity during our above night time closures to carry out a small amount of additional works on the A42 Junction 13 project. Traffic Management is a requirement for the safety of the travelling public and our workforce. There will be one lane closed on both North and South bound slip roads along with the inner ring of the Flagstaff roundabout. Carrying out the works during this time will alleviate the need to implement any extra night time closures to carry out the small amount of additional works required.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your co-operation and patience during our works and especially the latter stages of our project, where road closures are necessary.

We appreciate the inconvenience involved and your help is greatly appreciated by our team here in Ashby.
