

Weekly Construction Update – 24th November 2017

## Discovery Way, A511 Bypass and Tesco Roundabout Improvements

### THIS WEEK

Excavation work preparing the ground to match the level of the new road formation has been ongoing on the splitter island on Discovery Way at the junction with the A511 bypass. The installation of ducting to accommodate the infrastructure for the new lighting columns and signs is ongoing along with the laying of Type 1 stone. On the Tesco Roundabout, the manholes have been reset to the new surface course level and new signs have been installed.

On the west side of the northbound carriageway on the A511 Ashby Bypass new ducting has been installed for the infrastructure for the new traffic signals. The base and binder layer on the new widened area has been installed. Completion of the carriageway surface course has taken place during night time hours across the extent of the roundabout and on the A511 Ashby Bypass carriageway widening. Road lining works are due to commence.

### NEXT WEEK

Progress will continue to enhance minimal disruption for drivers throughout the lead up to the festive period. The A511 road widening area is programmed to be completed by the end of the week, traffic management will be lifted and the new carriageway fully opened. Works will be completed on the splitter island on Discovery Way with the installation of ducting for the infrastructure of the new lights and signs. Road line marking works will continue. The exit at the junction of Discovery Way and the A511 Bypass is in its last week of closure and is programmed to be open on 1<sup>st</sup> December in time for the busy Christmas Shopping period.

**Full night time road closures are ongoing on all approaches to the Tesco roundabout until 30<sup>th</sup> November from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am on Monday to Friday nights only. A signed diversion route is in place.** Thank you for your co-operation and understanding during these necessary night time re surfacing works. It is very much appreciated by our onsite team.

### A42/A511/A512 Flagstaff Roundabout Update

Works installing ducting, cabling and some signage and new street lighting columns for the Highways England network on the A42 slip roads, have taken place during this last week. Adhoc closures on the A42 slip roads are ongoing and will remain in place until works are completed installing the final road signs. This is programmed to be completed by the end of next week.
