**Working draft Equality Impact Assessment Report

# WDES

**Non-technical summary**

Provides a summary in non-technical language of the information included within other volumes of the working draft Environmental Statement.

**Glossary of terms and list of abbreviations**

Contains terms and abbreviations, including units of measurement used throughout the working draft Environmental Statement.

**Volume 1: Introduction and methodology**

Provides an overview of the Proposed Scheme and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process.

**Volume 3: Route-wide effects**

Describes the effects that are likely to occur at a geographical scale greater than the community areas described in the Volume 2: Community area reports, based on a stage in the ongoing design and environmental assessment.

**Volume 4: Off-route effects**

Provides an overview of anticipated off-route works and surrounding environment (where locations are known). These works are at an early stage of design and will be reported in full in the formal ES.

**Volume 2: Community Area (CA) Reports**

Consists of 28 reports and their associated map books, where available. These reports set out the design and environmental assessment for the Proposed Scheme at this stage, at a community area level. These reports are shown below.

- an outline of measures to monitor the adverse effects of the Proposed Scheme on the environment.



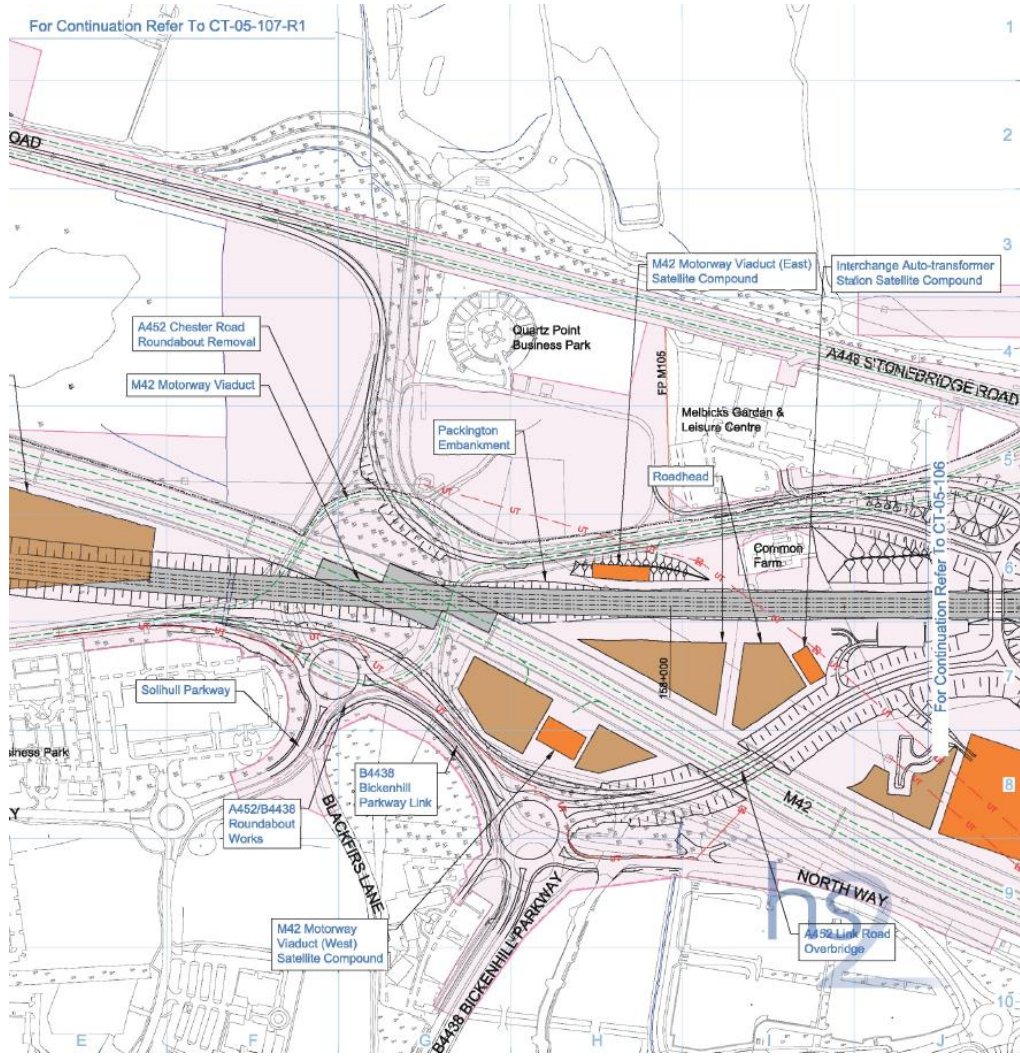

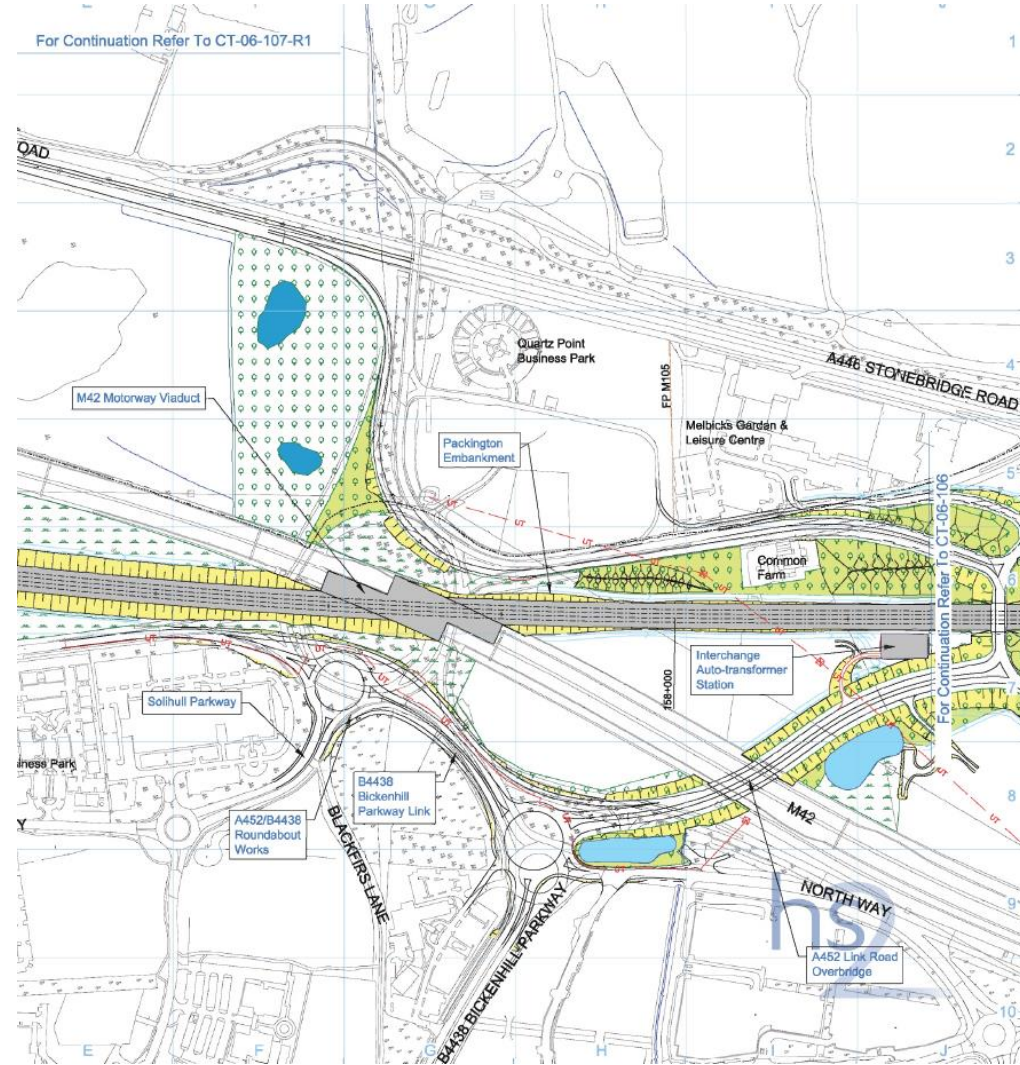


# Phase One Map Book Examples

# Supporting documents

- **EIA Scope and Methodology Report (SMR):** A technical document that outlines the approach to the EIA, which was subject to consultation in July 2017. A Consultation Summary Report for the EIA SMR has been included with the working draft ES alongside an updated version of the SMR itself which takes into consideration comments received, where appropriate, in addition to changes required as a result of updates to legislation or industry best practice guidance.
- **Alternatives report:** Describes the evolution of the Proposed Scheme and the reasonable alternatives studied during design development. This excludes local alternatives considered since the Government's confirmation of the route in July 2017. More recent alternatives are in the Vol 2 Community Area reports.
- **Draft Code of Construction Practice (CoCP):** Contains a series of measures and standards of work to provide effective planning, management and control of potential impacts on individuals, communities and the environment during construction. The draft CoCP will evolve and be amended as necessary during consultation and on going design and assessment up to deposit of the hybrid Bill. It will be finalised at Royal Assent.





# Working draft Equality Impact Assessment

The objectives underpinning the EqIA are to:

- identify the presence of Protected Characteristic Groups (PCG) along the route of the Proposed Scheme;
- inform the understanding of likely needs of those groups, relevant to identified potential effects;
- assess the potential effects of the Proposed Scheme's construction and operation for PCGs;
- identify measures, including reasonable adjustments, to avoid, minimise and/or mitigate potential negative equality effects on PCGs; and
- identify relevant measures, which as part of design or mitigation, can further enhance equality or address existing disadvantages.
